

Instructions

Choose an at-risk species to research (must be in Canada). Make sure that you are using reliable web sites that contain up to date information and that you cross-reference your material with multiple sites.

What You Need to Include:

1. Where does this species live? Where can it no longer be found? (1 mark)
2. Why is it at-risk? List at least 3 causes of this (being eaten by predators does not count). (3 marks)
3. What classification of at-risk species does it fit into (endangered, extirpated, etc.)? (1 mark)
4. Are there any initiatives underway to improve the status of this species? Be specific with who the organization is and what they are doing to help the species. (2 marks)
5. What could YOU do to help? Come up with at least 2 ideas. (2marks)
6. Provide a picture of your chosen species. (1 mark)
7. You must use and list at least 3 references (websites, books) to complete the research for this activity. (1 mark)
8. Compile your information into a creative and informative brochure. (4 marks for overall presentation and creativity)
