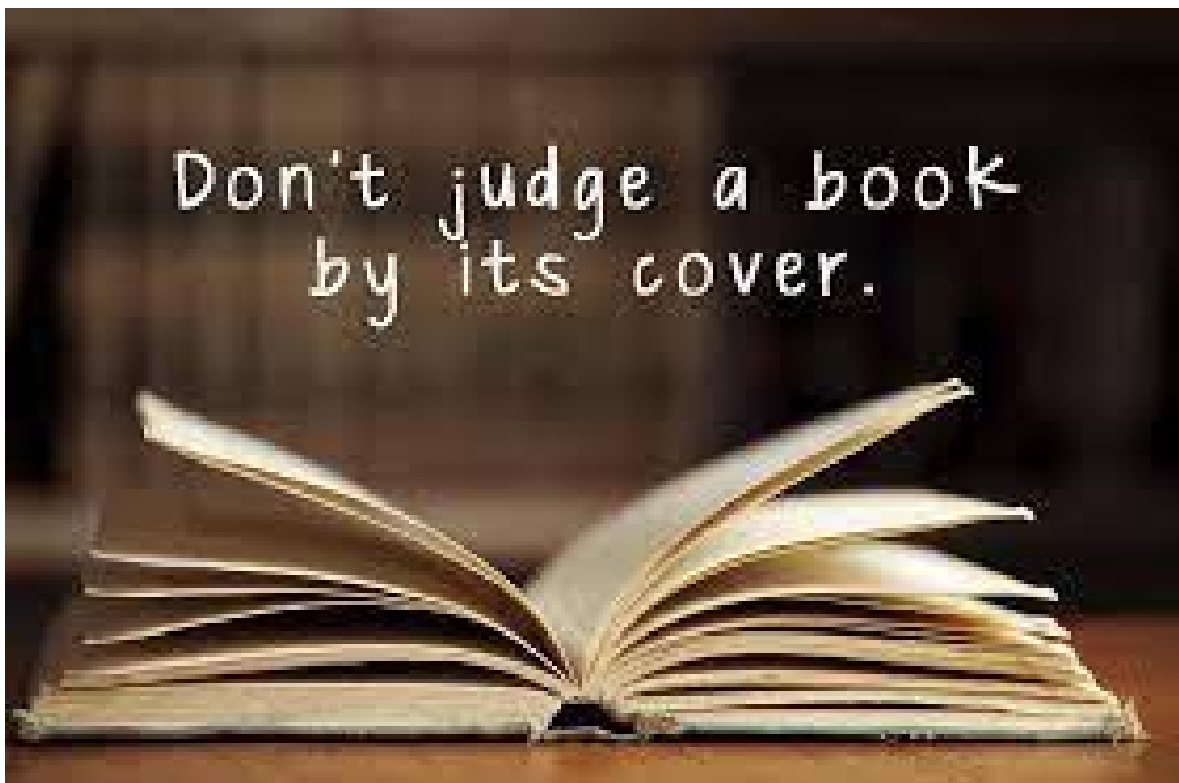


What does this mean literally? (In terms of books)
